EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENT STATE OF CALIFORNIA PROCLAMATION OF A STATE OF EMERGENCY

Due to Severe Drought in California, Governor Newsom directed local water suppliers to execute their Urban Water Shortage Contingency Plans on October 19, 2021.

Water Conservation Rules

- Outdoor Irrigation Sundown to Sunup
- Outdoor Irrigation limited to 3-days a week.
- No Outdoor Irrigation within 48 hours after measurable rainfall.
- If the property address is an even number, outdoor irrigation is allowed on Sunday, Wednesday, and Friday only.
- If the property address is an odd number, outdoor irrigation is allowed on Tuesday, Thursday, and Saturday only.
- All outside irrigation is prohibited on Mondays.
- Prohibit the application of potable water to outdoor landscapes in a manner that causes runoff such that water flows onto adjacent property, non-irrigated areas, private and public walkways, roadways, parking lots, or structures.
- The use of a hose to wash a car without a shut-off nozzle or device.
